- Food, Beverages, Candy or gum
- Money
- Silly string
- Water balloons
- Permanent markers
- Aerosol bug repellent
- Fireworks
- Knives
- Expensive jewelry
- Expensive clothing
- Parental-advisory music or video games
- Shelf or drawer unit for storing clothing
- Aerosol hair dye/color
- Any other item that your good judgment tells you has the potential to cause a mess or property damage in a camp setting
